




# **Question 1**


The diagram below describes the process of making recycled paper.




The chart below gives information on the birth rate among women in England, from 1973 to 2020. The figures are measured in births per 1000 women.



The charts below give information on a bus company's services between 1999 and 2003, including the target and actual percentage of buses that arrived on time, and the number of customer complaints.




The pie chart and table below give information on tourists visiting Australia.


The charts below show the amount of rainfall and the average monthly maximum and minimum temperatures for two Australian cities in the year 2018.

#### Average temperatures in Melbourne and Cairns


Average rainfall in Melbourne and Cairns
